Addison E. Sheldon Memorial Award

THE ADDISON E. SHELDON MEMORIAL AWARD was created in 1973. The award is given annually to an individual or organization for "outstanding contributions to the preservation and interpretation in the field of Nebraska History." Individuals or organizations may qualify for the Sheldon Award for long-term contributions to history or for an important one-time accomplishment. A committee drawn from the current NSHS Board of Trustees, the NSHS Emeritus Trustees, and the NSHS staff nominates/selects the recipient. Nominations may be solicited from staff, the membership, and the general public. The award consists of a plaque and a lifetime membership in the Nebraska State Historical Society.
