WHAT IS TRAILBLAZER?

Trailblazer is a newspaper-formatted publication designed specifically for use in the 4th grade classroom. Each issue presents a subject from Nebraska history in a way that is accessible and appealing to 4th grade students and can easily be used to supplement your Nebraska history textbooks. Only one copy of this packet is being sent to each school. If you have more than one 4th-grade classroom in your school, please work with your colleagues to create just one order for your entire school.

WANT MORE THAN 4 ISSUES?

You are welcome to order more than the 4 free issues for your students. Extra issues are available to you at a cost of \$.10 per copy plus a small postage and handling fee. A separate order form is included for these paid orders. Payment must be included with these orders for additional issues.

LATE ORDERS

If we do not receive your order request by the **JUNE 30, 2015 deadline** we will not be able to ship your order in September. We place an order for *Trailblazers* with our printer in early July based on the order forms that we have received by the deadline. If we receive your order after that deadline we will process it after September's mailing, depending on the remaining stock we have on hand. If we do not have enough copies of an issue that you have requested, we will substitute an issue of a similar topic.
