TO ALL WHO SHALL SEE THESE PRESENTS,

IN CONSIDERATION of the fidelity, zeal, and attachment testified by *The. W. Clark (two sides of a Cow) third Chief Soldier*
of the Mankos Nation to the government of the UNITED STATES; and by virtue of the power and authority
in me vested, I do hereby confirm the said *The. W. Clark third Chief* ^{Soldier} *of the Mankos Nation*
aforesaid, having bestowed upon him the *third silver medal*; willing all and singular the
Indians, inhabitants thereof, to obey him as a *third Ch. S.*; and all officers and others in the service of the UNITED
STATES to treat him accordingly.
